RULES & REGULATIONS
GOVERNING STREET VENDING FOR CHRISTMAS 2022

- 1) Vending fees are:
 - a. Food - \$300.00
 - b. Clothes - \$300.00
 - c. Toys, gifts, etc. - \$300.00
 - d. Small trays & coolers - \$150.00
 - e. Small trays only - \$125.00
 - f. Alcoholic Beverage - \$250.00
 - g. Christmas Week December 19th – 24th, 2022 - \$150.00
 - h. Christmas Eve only December 24th, 2022 - \$50.00

- 2) a) Vendors are allowed to erect a tent in their designated area/spot (10x10ft max), absolutely **no tents** are allowed **in the streets**.

 b) **All tents must be removed at the end of each day; failure to comply will result in the tents being removed by St. John’s Development Corporation and a fee of \$100.00 must be paid for the return of the tents.**

- 3) Vendors are only allowed to sell the list of goods/items specified on the approved vending application.
- 4) Vendors are prohibited from selling in any other area than that which was designated by the St. John’s Development Corporation.
- 5) All food vendors must possess the amenities required by the CBH for safe food handling and food vendors using **Bar-be-que grills** must have a fire extinguisher while plying their trade.
- 6) Vendors must keep their stalls/spots/tables/fittings and surrounding area clean at all times.
- 7) Vendors should not cause a nuisance or annoyance to any member of the public during this vending period. Failure to comply will result in the revocation of your license.
- 8) Vendors must pay a mandatory alternate fee of \$50.00 and a Clean Up Fee of EC \$20.00
- 9) Payment of vending fees are non – refundable.
- 10) Vending fee are for the entire period and shall not be discounted.

COVID-19 Protocols for Christmas Vending 10th December 2022 - 07th January, 2023

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic it is expected that the protocols established by the Ministry of Health are adhered to. Failure to respect and adhere to these protocols would result in the revocation of the License. Please find listed below the protocols.

Protocols

Each vendor shall ensure that their stall/tent/food van/vehicle, are equipped with:

- Hand sanitizer containing at least 70% alcohol base.
- Running water to wash hands, especially if handling food items.
- The wearing of Masks is mandatory for both the vendor and customer.
- Disposable cleaning tools such as wipes /disinfectant or similar products to disinfect the stall/tables under the tent.
- Regular cleaning of the vending area.
- Disposable Gloves.
- Social distancing. Ensure that your operation is six feet from the other vendor and the customer. The use of tent sides if available.
- Limit the number of persons to be attended to. No more than two persons at any one time.
- When handling food have one person separately to handle the money.
- Do not encourage a crowd to gather at your business.
- Do not encourage customers to touch items or food. Have them point to you instead. Disinfect each item after handling.
- The Vendor must always practice proper hygiene and grooming standards.
- If you are sick or you have been exposed to (or suspect that you have been exposed to) COVID-19, we ask that you **Do Not** come out to vend. We also encourage coughing and sneezing etiquette.
